The spread wing eagle on the reverse bright red, Early check with eagle from Carlisle Deposit Bank dated July 5, 1864 (civil war era), Early Check from the Franklin Bank state of Ohio Sept 9, 1871 with red eagle, \$5 State of Illinois Internal Improvement bill dated Aug 15, 1840 with a winged flying angel, \$5 1882 Brown Back U.S. \$10 National Bank Note with a lovely vignette of Ben Franklin flying a kite showing a representation of his famous experiment with electricity, and Five Pound Colonial currency bill from Pennsylvania April 10, 1775 showing the Walnut Street jail, site of the first manned balloon flight in the U.S. by Frenchman named Jean Pierre Blanchard which took place on Jan 9, 1793.
