What's in your pocket?

For this edition, I will move from the pocket to the wallet. Ever wonder where the bills in your wallet were spent? There is a website for that Where'sGeorge.com. This site tracks the serial numbers of specially marked bills showing where and how far that bill traveled since it was spent. Ever since it was established in 1998, notes totaling \$1.57 Billion have been entered in the database. All denominations printed after 1963 are eligible to be tracked but the one dollar bills are most popular. Where's George notes are identified by a stamp promoting the website. Although the notes are only worth face value, some people seek-out and collect notes with multiple entries. The most desirable are notes reported to be spent in all 50 states.
